You may be asked to pay over the phone, or send a replacement check. **Watch your statements** to see if the check has been cashed (for the same amount sent) and if so, let Eversource know that. If cashed for a different amount, let your bank know, in case they have been stolen and "washed".

**Free COVID and Flu VACCINES! New COVID-19 boosters target the BA.4 and BA.5** Omicron subvariants - available for people aged 5 years and older.

**Covid Home Test kits:** many insurance plans will cover up to 8 tests per month per person. CVS has it set up on their website to order test kits. Walgreens also is offering help. They run them through your insurance and then you can pick them up in store. **Expiration dates on some COVID tests** have been **extended** - check the updates. Do a Google search by brand. Look again later for extension updates.

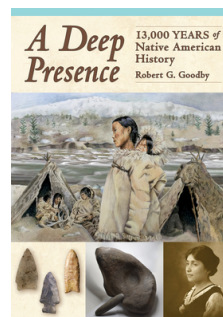

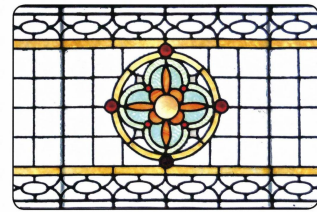
