**Warner Community Power** will begin serving Warner residents with low cost and flexibly sourced energy supply in **March**. Last year, Warner residents voted at Town Meeting to join the energy cooperative managed by **Community Power Coalition of NH** which will purchase energy on our behalf, and on behalf of the growing number of other towns, cities and counties who are CPCNH members. Residents without other fixed contracts or solar are automatically opted in. Energy users in Warner can see options and select which energy choice works best for them, including the % of renewables.
