Habitat for Humanity is coming back to Warner next week for a project on East Joppa Road. Work is scheduled for Monday through Friday, April 22-26, 8 am to 4 pm. You will also need to sign the waiver form.

Work scope includes new roof, underlayment repair, and plumbing repairs, and volunteer helpers are needed for site support tasks like:

- Pick up roof debris (total of 7,000 lbs!) from the ground and load into dump trailer
- Move 7,000 lb of new shingles from the delivery pile to the bottom of the power ladder
- Help remove compromised underlayment and load into dump trailer
- Help move flooring material to team of people installing the vinyl floor
- Be available to pick up material from Cyr Lumber or Ace Hardware
- Pick up lunch for the crew from a local restaurant
