### Rethink, Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Repair

**Reduce your taxes: Recycle!** Warner Fees for solid waste disposal in 2023 (not including demolition waste and special disposal items) were \$76,091 (\$85/ton)! **Paper, corrugated cardboard and metals create income**, so please don't put these, or

glass or recyclable plastics in the compactor, which costs Warner \$\$ per ton and fills the landfill with unnecessary waste ash.

**Stretchy plastics** may be dropped off **in the TREX box on the porch** of the Parish House next to the United Church of Warner for the Simonds School TREX bench project. Acceptable items **stretch when you pull.** If it tears like paper, or is shiny or makes a crinkly/crunchy sound, do NOT recycle in the bins. <a href="https://nextrex.com/view/educate">https://nextrex.com/view/educate</a>
